Are you ready for a summer reading challenge?

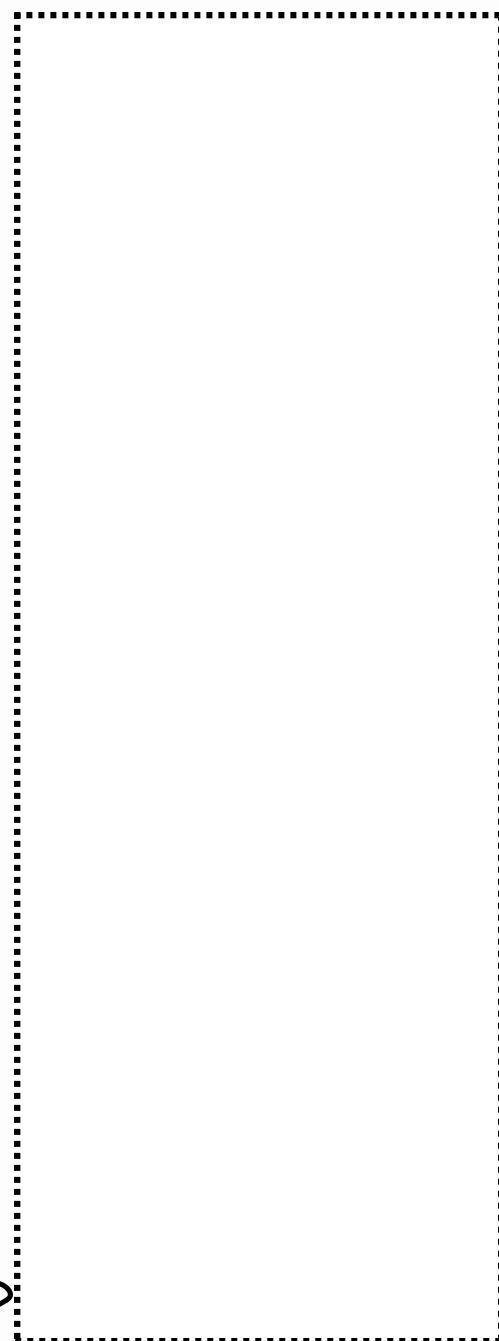

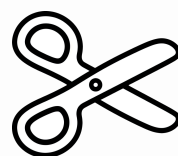
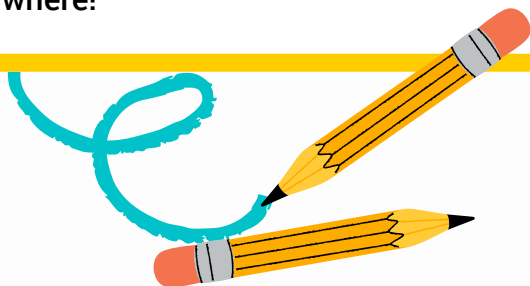
Design Your Own Bookmark

Have a wonderful summer, keep reading, and remember: **A book is an adventure you can take anywhere!**





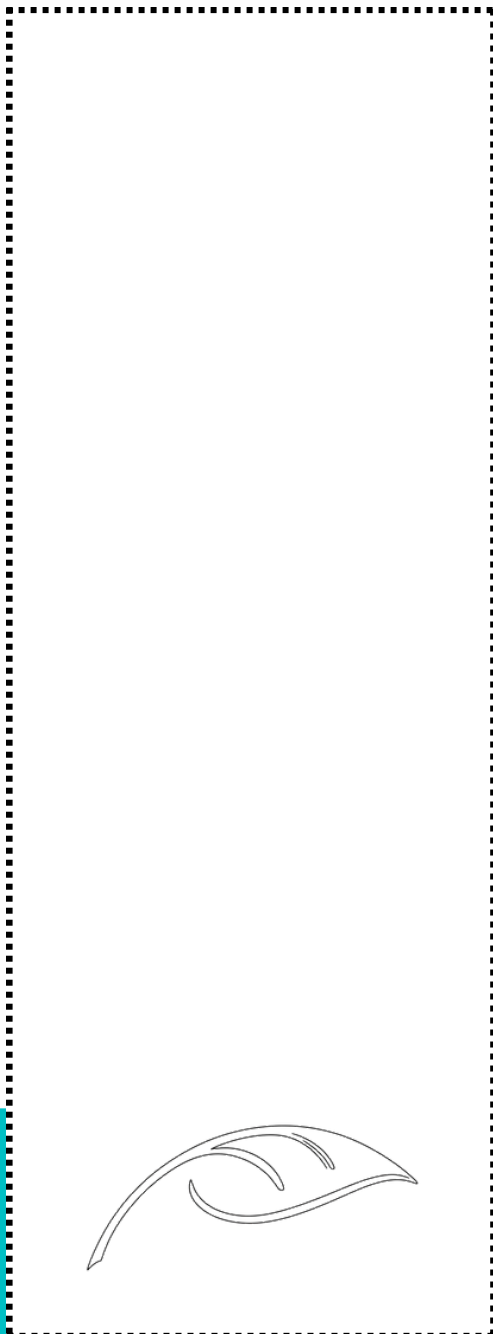
